"The purpose of the Project is to improve the I-229 Exit 5 Interchange and the segment of 26th Street from I-229 through Southeastern Avenue to meet current design standards, accommodate existing and future traffic needs by meeting Federal, State, and City capacity and level of service (LOS) criteria".
